## About the symposium

On 13 May a symposium will be organized by the former partners of the INTUIT-project (<a href="www.intuitproject.nl">www.intuitproject.nl</a>) and affiliated projects. The topic of INTUIT - English language teaching in Higher Education, based on the CEF and supported by ICT - will be revisited.
